# **Securite - Navigational Warning**

## 1. Purpose

**1.1** The purpose of this LOP is to provide a guide and template to Marine Rescue Sydney (MR Sydney) members to draft a script relating to a Navigational Warning – Securite broadcast.

#### 2. The Process

- **2.1** All requests for Navigational Warning broadcasts are to be authorised by personnel from MRNSW HQ (eg ROMs, Director Operations) or by UC, DUC, Operations Officer, Deputy Operations Officer.
- **2.2** If MRS has taken responsibility over a remote MR Base, we will broadcast warnings as requested either by an authorised person as per 2.1 on behalf of the MR Base or requested by the member from the remote MR Base during handover.
- **2.3** The remote base, and person requesting a navigational Warning ideally should provide preferably by email, the script and the details relating to broadcast times and the radio/channel (s) which the broadcast is to be made.
- 2.4 If a script for the navigational warning broadcast is not provided, all details of the broadcasts are to be provided to MR Sydney to complete a script using then template (see Addendum1). MR Sydney member is to ensure details are clear and understood before accepting.
- **2.5** A hard copy is also found in the forms folder and a soft copy on the desktop of a standalone computer in the radio room. MR Sydney Members is encouraged to use the soft copy to draft a new script but to ensure the template is kept in its original format for future use, to save the script being drafted in a different name.
- **2.6** Seahawk communication log is to be updated after each broadcast (care to be taken to record broadcast against the correct MR Base).
- 2.7 On occasions, members are required to sign on a records sheet that the broadcast was done on the time scheduled in addition to recording the communication on Seahawk. (A template in excel format is located on the desktop of a standalone computer in the radio room).
